**Subject :** Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts from Performing Duties  
(No Gift Policy) Fiscal Year B.E. 2567 (2024)

Tardthongphitayakom School recognizes the importance of enhancing organizational culture, values, and suitable guidelines for employees to adhere to practices related to giving or taking gifts, rewards, or other benefits from performing duties. This is aimed at preventing actions that could lead to the abuse of power for personal or others' benefits, in accordance with the National Reform Plan to prevent corruption and misconduct.

To demonstrate the intention and determination to resist corruption in all its forms, the Secondary Educational Service Area Office Udon Thani is committed to opposing all forms of corruption and misconduct while striving to enhance morality, ethics, and honesty in the execution of duties. This drive for transparency within personnel operations aligns with the principles of Good Governance. All government agencies will implement the No Gift Policy, which prohibits accepting any presents or gifts in the course of performing their duties. This policy applies to awards or rewards of any kind, whether given before, during, or after the performance of duties. The aim is to avoid actions that may affect impartiality or decision-making, which could lead to biased actions or conflicts of interest. Directors and supervisors at all levels act as good examples, guiding staff to behave correctly and adhere rigorously to measures to prevent corruption and misconduct.

This announcement shall be informed and observed accordingly.
